Gatsby Africa has established the Textiles Development Unit to support Tanzania's 10-year goal to develop a globally competitive sector employing 200,000 workers and exporting over \$1 billion of garments per year. The Unit has a long-term outlook and flexible approach, and the scope to think creatively and test innovative ways of catalysing change for large-scale impact.

The Senior Manager, Institutional Functions will play a key role in building long-term relationships with government agencies and the main industry association, working with them to formulate, advocate and implement public sector policy that supports reform and growth of the textiles sector.

This role will strategically assess the potential impact of different policy alternatives, analysing market, trade and financial data to help stakeholders understand the policies that will make the sector globally competitive. It will also aim to understand the legislative, regulatory, organisational and political economy drivers of performance of the key governmental bodies responsible for the textiles sector, including cross-cutting institutions.

The ideal candidate will have:

- 10 years' experience in some combination of private sector and /or public policy analysis roles.
- An understanding of public policy decision-making processes and of the means of influencing policy effectively.
- A passion for development, with a results-oriented approach.
- An ability to understand sector dynamics and approaches to transforming entire sectors, with a detailed understanding of private sector actors.
