Gatsby Africa has established the Textiles Development Unit to support Tanzania's 10-year goal to develop a globally competitive sector employing 200,000 workers and exporting over \$1 billion of garments per year. The Unit has a long-term outlook and flexible approach, and the scope to think creatively and test innovative ways of catalysing change for large-scale impact.

The Senior Manager, Sector and Industry Development role will be responsible for developing long term relationships within the textiles and garments sector in Tanzania.

This will include building relationships with actors in the formal sector operating in both the export and domestic markets, as well as those within the small-scale, semi-formal and informal sectors. In addition, the role will work with government and government agencies with responsibility for industry, industry regulation and oversight, and the wider industrialisation agenda.

The role will build capacity and support a coordinated cross-industry and cross-governmental approach to transforming the sector.

The ideal candidate will have:

- 10 years' experience in some combination of private sector and /or public policy analysis roles.
- A private sector outlook on development, with enthusiasm for promoting private sector investment to drive results.
- An ability to understand sector dynamics and approaches to transforming entire sectors, with a detailed understanding of private sector actors.
- Extremely strong analytical skills, including financial, economic and policy analysis skills.
